### Parish Accounts 2016

Overall the 2016 figures are very positive but it should be noted that our prime sources of income

(Offertory, Development & Community Newsletter) slightly down on previous years. Unfortunately this is a continuation of a trend we have seen over the last two years. Remedial action taken in 2017 seems to be improving the situation.
