Pope Francis's Invitation & Our Response

Pope Francis has invited every member of the Church throughout the world to share their experiences, insights and hopes for the Church. Every diocese has been asked to give opportunities for reflection, discussion and feedback in preparation for the Synod of Bishops in 2023. Here in the Diocese of Kerry there is the opportunity to share your thoughts on-line or to participate in person in the next 2 months. The goal is to ensure the participation of the greatest number possible, in order to listen to the living voice of the entire People of God.

This is not possible unless we make special efforts to actively reach out to people where they're at, especially those who are often excluded or who are not involved in the life of the Church.

There must be a clear focus on the participation of the poor, marginalized, vulnerable, and excluded, in order to listen to their voices and experiences.

The Synodal Process must be simple, accessible, and welcoming for all.



In some ways it is a simple concept, but in another sense difficult to explain. Perhaps the easiest way to get an initial understanding is to look at the picture from the Synodal Pathway Logo. It's a picture of the Church as we would like it to be ...... all of us journeying together ..... all of us with a story to tell ....... and in the coming months we will seek to give people a chance to tell their story.

LISTEN is going to be the key word ...... we will hear different views and opinions ...... Pope Francis wants to begin from the ground up ... so that the voice of all God's people under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, is enabled to be truly part of the conversation.

The Diocesan Launch of the Synodal Pathway takes place this weekend.
