#### **CONFIRMATION IN BATHMORE..,**

On last Thursday, last his Lordship, Most Rev Dr Coffey, Bishop of Kerry, attended at Rathmore Church, where he be\_administered the Sacrament of Confirmation to 345 children from Rathmore, Gneveguilla, and Knocknagee. His Lordship arrived shortly after noon, and immediately began the examination in the Christian doctrine, in which be was joined by the Rev H Scanlon CC, Rathmore, and the Rev W O'Connor, C C, do. The examination was severe and searching, and the children bravely bore the test, for not only did they manifest a sound and -intellectual knowledge of the Catechism, but they proved themselves to be theologians of no mean order The examination continued for several hours, and his\_Lordship seemed highly pleased with the satisfactory and brilliant display of Christian knowledge exhibited by the answering of the children. It would he invidious to allot out for special praise the children of any particular school, since all of the fifteen schools in the parish did so well. Suffice it to say that such a display of theological knowledge made by school children has seldom been equalled. The children themselves must be congratulated on their extensive and sound knowledge of the Christian doctrine at this early hour of their lives. Their teachers, too, must be congratulated on their successful teaching of the Catechism, for they have worked hard, not only during the immediate preparation before Confirmation, but during the year they have never failed either in church or school to give religious instruction, They have now been well rewarded by what they heard and saw last Thursday in Rathmore Church.

The priests of the parish, too, must be congratulated on the brilliant results of their teaching of the \_Catechism, and in order that it may be well explained, the two curates have assigned to them their respective districts for which they are responsible, and it is a well known fact in the parish that they have never omitted to make their weekly visit to their respective schools, and teach and explain the catechism during the time appointed by the time-table

The pariah priest, too,; must be congratulated that be has such energetic and zealous curates, and he seemed to be highly delighted with the day's proceedings. Confirmation over the Ceremony of the day was concluded by solemn Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament by the Bishop.
