The Story of Knock

At about 8 o'clock on the Thursday evening of the 21st of August,

1879, the Blessed Virgin Mary, St Joseph & St John the Evangelist

appeared at the South gable of the Church at Knock, County Mayo, Ireland.

Beside them and a little to the right was an altar with a cross and the figure of a lamb, around which angels hovered. There were fifteen official witnesses to the apparition - young and old - who watched it for two hours in pouring rain and recited the Rosary.

Two Commissions of Enquiry accepted their testimony as trustworthy and satisfactory in 1879 and 1936.

Today, Knock is one of the world's major Marian Shrines. It has received many Papal honours including the distinction of two Papal visits, that of St John Paul II in 1979 and Pope Francis in 2018.
