A trip down Memory Lane

DESCRIPTIVE PARTICULARS.

LOT No. 2, comprises the Townlands of Knocknagree and Farrankale, containing 856a 1r and 37p Measure, equivalent to 528a. 2r. 39p., Plantation Measure.

LOT No. 4, comprises the Townland of Park, containing 233a. 0r. 37p., Statute Measure, equivalent to 448a 3r 48p .

LOT No. 5, comprises the Townland of Scrahan, containing 304a. 2r. 1p , Statute Measure, equivalent to 187a. 3r 8p Plantation Measure.

All these Lots are situate in the Parish of Nohovaldaly, and Barony of _Duhallow ; and for Poor Law Purposes are situated in the Union of Millstreet, and Electoral Division of Knocknagree. A large portion of these Lots have been drained ; and on Lot No. 2, is Knocknagree House and Demesne, capable of being made a desirable resilience at a small expense.

All of these Lots are within about 2 miles of the _Killarney Junction Railway Station at Shinnagh.
